01. ELIGIBILITY

The CPG International Series Grand Final is open to professional and amateur players, with a maximum field size of 40 players. The Championship is by invitation only, to winners of CPG International Series events in 2025 & 2026 and those players listed in the CPG International Series Order of Merits 2025 & 2026. Any tournament invitations will be decided by the CPG Board of Directors whose decision is final. Any doubts as to eligibility will be decided by the CPG Board of Directors whose decision is final.

03. REGISTRATION & ENTRY FEE

Pre-event Registration: Competitors must register on Golf Genius using the link provided with their invitation email and provide full information and payment of the entry fee. Entries will not be accepted until all required information and payment is received.

Entry Fee: Competitors must pay the entry fee of €100 at the time of online registration. Relevant payment methods for each Competitor's country will be presented to them at the time of payment. Entry fees are refundable for competitors who withdraw before the entry deadline.

Deadline for entries: Friday 04 September 2026, 17:00 CEST

On-site registration: Competitors are required to register with a CPG official on arrival at Bois d'Arlon. The Tournament Office will be situated in the clubhouse/hotel.

Registration must be completed by 10:00am on Tuesday 15 September 2026

Data Use: Personal data of the participants required during the registration procedure are stored and will be used for purposes related to the staging of the event. Professionals and amateurs will be added in to the CPG database and are able to update preferences or unsubscribe from the database at any time. Participants also agree that their data may be shared with relevant CPG Partners/third parties for the purposes of providing them with ongoing opportunities and offers – participants will be able to unsubscribe from these communications at any time directly. By submitting an entry form or registering directly with organisers, each participant consents to the storing of their personal data and its use for the purposes of the event.

Participants consent to the use of their image during the event by the organisers, sponsors, or other partners of the event for promotional purposes, with no right to claim full or partial compensation for that reason.

04. CONDITIONS OF PLAY

The event will be played under the R&A Rules of Golf, CPG [Tournament Regulations](#), 2026 CPG Conditions of Competition and the local rules for The Heathland Course at Bois d'Arlon as determined by the CPG Tournament Director. All conditions of play and formats are subject to change.

Competitors will play a 36-hole individual Strokeplay tournament, with no cut on 16 & 17 September. In the event of a tie there will be a sudden death play-off, which will take place immediately after all players have confirmed their scores following the final round.

The play-off holes will be posted on the Championship noticeboard.

Female Professionals & Male Professionals Over 55 years of age:

Female Professionals & Male Professionals over 55 years of age playing in CPG Championships and Sanctioned Events/Pro-Ams for the same prize money will play a course that is not more than 10-14% shorter than the total course yardage played by the male professionals.

The Championship Director will vary tees as necessary to ensure the fairness of the course and the event.

Championship Prize Fund (subject to change):

The Professional Prize Fund is €30,000 based on a field of 40 players.

The Prize Fund is subject to change, and a CPG 6% Levy.

Pre-Championship Pro-Am prizes to be confirmed.

Any disputes regarding the interpretation of these Conditions of Competition will be settled by the CPG Tournament Director and will be binding.

Amateur Competitor Prize Money:

Amateur competitors in the Championship are eligible for prize money up to the maximum limit stated by the Rules of Amateur Status for scratch competitions of £700 / US\$1000 in value.

05. PRE-CHAMPIONSHIP PRO-AM (15 SEPTEMBER)

All professionals in the Grand Final are required to be available to play in the Pre-Championship Pro-Am. 20 professionals will be selected to play in the Pro-Am event and MUST make themselves available to play on the morning of 15 September if selected.

This is a mandatory requirement of entry into the Championship.

Pro-Am Conditions of Play:

Teams (consisting of 1 Grand Final Professional and 3 Amateurs) will compete in an 18-hole Stableford competition with the best two scores from the team of four to count on each hole.

On a specified hole, a guest Professional will compete with each team.

On this hole it is still the best 2 scores to count but from a 5-player team (team + guest Professional).

The handicap index limit is 28 for men and 36 ladies. This handicap index will be sloped first, then reduced to a 90% allowance. The resulting playing handicap will also be limited to 28 for men and 36 for ladies. The World Handicapping System (WHS) will apply to the tournament, and each amateur will play from the applicable playing handicap.

Pro-Am tees will be confirmed before the round.

06. ACCOMMODATION & TRAVEL

Information relating to booking accommodation on-site at Bois d'Arlon with special rates is available to view at <https://cp.golf/45dcpqg>.

Off-site accommodation is also available at the [Van der Valk Luxembourg Hotel](#) in Arlon, approximately a 10-minute drive from Bois d'Arlon.

Airports: The nearest airport to Bois d'Arlon is Luxembourg

All travel is at each competitors' own expense.

07. CHAMPIONSHIP COMMUNICATIONS

All tournament communications will be sent via email, so it is vital that **ALL COMPETITORS** regularly check email correspondence before, during and immediately after the Championship.

08. COMPETITOR FUNCTIONS

Information about all functions will be communicated by email.

Prize Presentation (17 Sept): The prize presentation will take place as soon as possible after the conclusion of the final round. Competitors finishing in 1st, 2nd and 3rd place are required to stay for the presentation. CPG requests that every competitor stays for the prize presentation to show their appreciation to the Championship's sponsors.

Grand Final Pro-Am Experience (14-15 Sept): A series of events will take place on Monday 14 and Tuesday 15 September with Nicolas Colsaerts and amateur teams that are entering separately to the championship. Competitors are able to join these events, but they must pre-register with Aston Ward at aw@cpg.golf. (Some additional costs may be applicable depending on which element is attended). Guests at this event will be playing in the Pre-Championship Pro-Am on 15 Sept – any Grand Final competitors required for this will be communicated with directly as mentioned above in Section 05.
